Paper Submission

Full papers in English not exceeding 12 pages are invited. Papers have to be formatted according to the Springer Lecture Notes in Computer Science (LNCS) template, and submitted in PDF format through [EasyChair](#). All submissions will be peer-reviewed by three members of the international Program Committee.

Proceedings

All accepted papers with paid registration fee will be published in the conference proceedings in the LNCS series by Springer. The registered participants will get free online access to the content on SpringerLink for a period of 4 weeks.
